**Invitation for Tenders**

1. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has received for a loan from Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the loan will be used to cover eligible payments under the contract for the **Construction of Kizengi Weighbridge including fixing of reflectors and solar street lighting along Tabora – Nyahua - Chaya Road, Tender No. AE/001/2022-23/HQ/W/54.**
2. Tanzania National Roads Agency, on behalf of the Ministry of Works and Transport now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for **Construction of Kizengi Weighbridge including Fixing of Reflectors and Solar Street Lighting along Tabora – Nyahua - Chaya Road, Tender No. AE/001/2022-23/HQ/W/54.**
3. Tendering will be conducted through the International Competitive Tendering method specified in the Public Procurement Regulations, Government Notice No.446 of 2013 as amended, and Kuwait Fund Procurement Guidelines and is open to all Tenderers as defined in the Bidding documents.
4. A margin of preference will be applied to a Joint Venture (JV) between Tanzanian and Kuwait Contractors. For such a Joint Venture, a margin of preference of 5% above the lowest evaluated Bid will be applied. However, for a Tenderer to qualify as a Joint Venture the Contractors constituting the JV must be owned or beneficially owned to the extent of not less than 51% by Tanzania or Kuwait nationals, or entities respectively and any such corporate entity must satisfy the same criterion of ownership.
5. The Works consist of construction of embankment, drainage structures, solar street lighting as well as pavement layers and ancillary works. The estimated major quantities of works are as follows: -

6. Tenderers should note that to qualify for award of the contract, they are required to meet certain minimum qualifying criteria which includes:
  - (i) Tenderers must be able to demonstrate that, in the capacity as a Prime Contractor, Sub-contractor, or management Contractor they should have successfully completed **at least two (2) projects** of similar nature and complexity each with a minimum **TZS 15 billion** within the **last ten (10) years.**
  - (ii) Provide full and detailed particulars of their financial capability to perform such works and to demonstrate that they have experienced key personnel with appropriate qualifications. As part of proof of experience on road project,
  - (iii) Tenderers are required to submit certified forms of Contract for awarded Contract in the past, taking over and Completion Certificates duly certified together with Telephone Number and e-mail addresses of the previous Employer/Awarding Agency).Further details and complete qualification requirements are provided in the Tendering Documents.
7. Tenderers should also note that the works must be completed within **Twelve (12) months inclusive of One (1) months of mobilisation** and that they are required to provide detailed particulars of all items of equipment and plant that they deem necessary to deploy for the timely completion of the works. **Tenderers who are proven non-performers need not apply as they will be disqualified”**
8. Interested eligible Tenderers may obtain further information and inspect the Tendering Documents at the office of the **Secretary, TANROADS Headquarters Tender Board 2nd Floor, 10Shaban Robert Road/ Garden Avenue Junction, P.O. Box 11364, Dar es Salaam** from 8:00hours to 16:30hours local time, Monday to Friday inclusive except on public Holidays.
9. A complete set of Tendering Document(s) in English may be obtained in English Language and additional sets may be purchased by interested tenderers upon submission of a written application to the address given in paragraph six above and upon payment of non-refundable fee of **TZS 300,000.00 (Tanzania Shillings Three Hundred Thousands Only).** The method of payment will be through the Control Number to be provided by TANROADS. 10. All Tenders must be accompanied by a Tender Security in an acceptable form in the amount of **TZS 1,500,000,000.00 (Tanzania shillings One Billion Five Hundred Million Only)** or an equivalent amount in some freely convertible currencies in case of foreign Tenderers.
11. A combined Site visit and Pre-tender meeting will be held on **6th February, 2023** at the Regional Manager’s office, TANROADS, Tabora Region. The site visit will commence at **09:00 hours local time.**
12. All tender in **One (1 ) original plus three (3 ) copies**, properly filled in and enclosed in a plain envelope must be delivered to the **Secretary, TANROADS Headquarters Tender Board 2nd Floor, 10Shaban Robert Road/Garden Avenue Junction, P.O. Box 11364 Dar es Salaam** at or before 10:00 Hours local time on **21st February 2023.** Tenders will be opened prompt thereafter in public and in the presence of tenderers representative who choose to attend in the opening at the **TANROADS Headquarters conference Room, 2nd Floor, 10Shaban Robert Road/Garden Avenue Junction, P.O. Box 11364 Dar es Salaam**
13. Late Tenders, Portion of Tenders, Electronic Tenders, Tender not received, Tender not opened and not read out in Public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstance.
