INVITATION FOR TENDERS
UPGRADING OF TABORA – NYAHUA - CHAYA ROAD TO BITUMEN
STANDARD, LOT 2: NYAHUA- CHAYA SECTION (85.4 KM)

- 1- The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has applied for a loan from Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the loan will be used to cover eligible payments under the contract for the **Upgrading of Tabora – Nyahua - Chaya Road to Bitumen Standard, Lot 2: Nyahua - Chaya Section (85.4 Km), Tender No. AE/00117-2016//HQ/W/14.**
- 2- The Tanzania National Roads Agency (TANROADS), an Agency of the Ministry of Works, Transport and Communication, hereinafter referred to as the Employer now invites sealed tenders from eligible and capable Contractors for carrying out **Upgrading of Tabora – Nyahua - Chaya Road to Bitumen Standard, Lot 2: Nyahua - Chaya Section (85.4 Km), Tender No. AE/00117-2016//HQ/W/14.**
- 3- Tendering will be conducted through the International Competitive Tendering (ICT) Method specified in the Public Procurement Regulations, 2013 and Kuwait Fund Procurement Guidelines and is open to all Tenderers as defined in the Bidding documents.
- 4- A margin of preference will be applied to a Joint Venture (JV) between Tanzanian and Kuwait Contractors. For such a Joint Venture, a margin of preference of 5% above the lowest evaluated Bid will be applied. However, for a Tenderer to qualify as a Joint Venture the Contractors constituting the JV must be owned or beneficially owned to the extent of not less than 51% by Tanzania or Kuwait nationals, or entities respectively and any such corporate entity must satisfy the same criterion of ownership.
- 5- The works consist of the upgrading of the road from unpaved road to Bitumen standard and construction of new drainage structures. The estimated quantities for major items of works are as follows:

- 6- Tenderers should note that to qualify for award of the contract, they are required to meet certain minimum qualifying criteria. It should be noted that tenderers must be able to demonstrate that, in the capacity as a prime Contractor, they should have successfully completed at least two (2) projects of similar nature of at least 60 km within the last ten (10) years. Tenderers are required to provide full and detailed particulars of their financial capability to perform such works and to demonstrate that they have experienced key personnel with appropriate qualifications. As part of proof of experience on road project, Tenderers are required to submit certified forms of Contract for awarded Contracts in the past, Taking Over and Completion Certificates duly certified together with Telephone Number and e-mail addresses of the previous Employer/Awarding Agency. Tenderers should also note that the works must be completed within a period of **thirty nine (39) months inclusive of three (3) months of mobilisation** and that they are required to provide detailed particulars of all items of equipment and plant that they deem necessary to deploy for the timely completion of the works. **Bidders who are proven non-performers need not apply as they will be disqualified.**

- 8- A complete set of bidding documents (and additional copies) may be purchased by interested Tenderers at the above office, on submission of a written application to the address given above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **TZS 300,000 (Tanzania Shillings Three Hundred Thousand Only)** or its equivalent in freely convertible currency for each set, payable by Banker's Cheque, Banker's Draft or Cash to the **Chief Executive, Tanzania National Roads Agency (TANROADS), P.O. - 9- The tender shall be valid for a period of 120 days after Tender opening, and must be accompanied by a "Tender Security" in original and in an acceptable form in the amount of **TZS 800,000,000 (Tanzania Shillings Eight Hundred Million Only)** or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency, and the Tender must be submitted or sent by a registered post clearly addressed to: **The Secretary, TANROADS Headquarters Tender Board, 4th Floor, Airtel House, Ali Hassan Mwinyi/Kawawa Roads Junction, P. O. Box 11364, Dar es Salaam, TANZANIA** so as to reach him on or before the deadline for submission of tenders.

The Tender Security shall be clearly addressed to: **The Chief Executive, TANROADS, P. O. Box 11364, Dar es Salaam.**
The Tender Security shall be valid for **Twenty eight days (28)** beyond the end of the validity of the tender.

- 10- The deadline for submission of Tenders shall be at **10:00 Hours** local time on **13th March, 2017.**
Tenders will be opened in public at TANROADS Conference Room, **4th Floor, TANROADS Headquarters, Airtel House, Ali Hassan Mwinyi/Kawawa Roads Junction, Dar es Salaam,** immediately after submission deadline and in the presence of Tenderers' Representatives who choose to attend.
